SUBJECT: Joint Use Agreement with the Lake Elsinore Unified School District for the Joint Use of Library Facilities located at Lakeside High School

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

- 1) Approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached Joint Use Agreement with the Corona-Norco Unified School District for the Joint Use of Library Facilities located at Lakeside High School.
- 2) Authorize the use of \$300,000 of the Western Riverside County Library Book Fund for an opening day collection of library materials.

BACKGROUND: This agreement with Lake Elsinore Unified School District will enable the County Library to operate a public library at Lakeside High School in a library facility that will be jointly used with the school. Both the library and school will open once construction is completed in late summer 2005. Initially the library will be open 72 hours per week for both students and public.

Form 11 – Joint Use Agreement with Lake Elsinore Unified School District

The County Library and District will each provide their own staff that will be cross-trained to serve both the public and students. The District will pay for the construction of the facility and most furniture and equipment. The County Library will provide the District access to the new County Library automated computer system which will be utilized by both entities to track users and catalog materials. The County Library will pay the District \$2,297 per month for use of the facility, which includes maintenance, custodial services, and utilities.

Operational costs will be included in the Fiscal Year 2005/2006 contract with Library Systems and Services (LSSI) for operation of the County Library System. The Western County Library Book Fund will provide \$300,000 for an initial opening day collection of public library materials.

The County Librarian will oversee this agreement.
