RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- (1) assess the reasonable costs of abatement of a public nuisance (four (4) substandard structures) in the above-referenced matter to be seven thousand, four hundred, seventy dollars and forty-eight cents (US \$7,470.48);
- (2) assess the costs of abatement against the above-described subject property;
- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien; and
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment.


BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 457 (RCC Title 15) and 725(h-1) (RCC Chapter 1.16) authorize for the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors issued an Order to Abate in this case on July 2, 2002. Subsequently, the property owners brought the property into compliance prior to a seizure warrant being issued.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 1998.

All notices regarding the Statement of Expense hearing have been given to Aldine Wells, Carolyn J. Sims, Anne Gago and Sandra Bowens, the property owners, as required by law (see attached exhibits).
