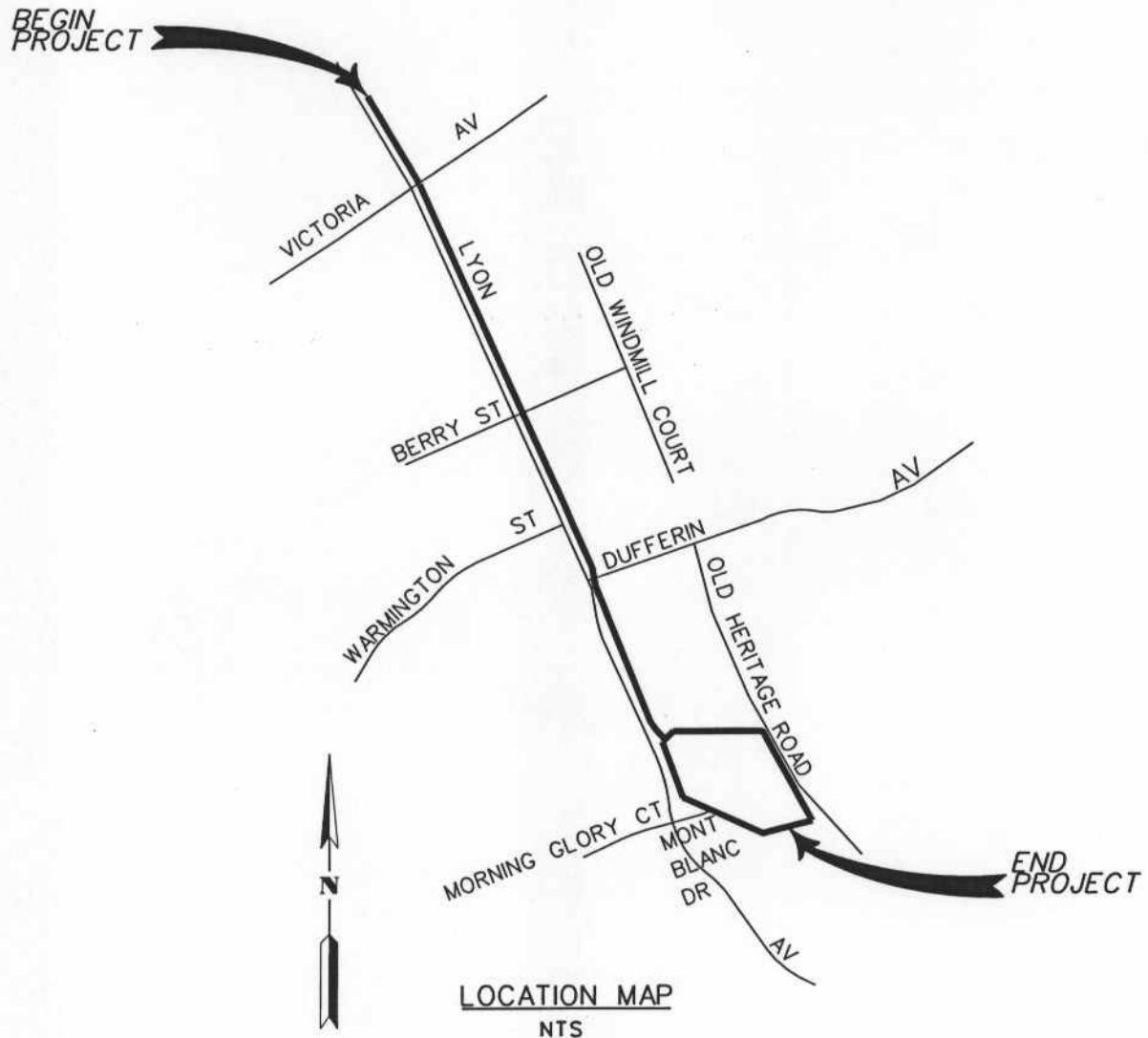

SW RIVERSIDE MDP LINE "C" STAGE 5 PROJECT NO.1-0-0170



SW Riverside MDP Line "C", stage 5 consists of constructing approximately 2270 lineal feet of an underground storm drain beginning at the upstream terminus of the stage 4 construction located north of the street intersection of Lyon Avenue and Victoria Avenue, then southeasterly along Lyon Avenue and ending in a mitigation basin near the street intersection of Lyon Avenue and Mont Blanc Drive.
