RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Inland Counties Legal Services.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: These agreements represent the last year of the four year 01-05 RFP contracting cycle.

The agreement with Inland Counties Legal Services covering the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$66,500 continues the provisions of Legal Assistance to the seniors of Riverside County.

Legal Assistance consists of legal representation by a member of the California State Bar or by a non-attorney under the supervision and control of a member of the California State Bar to ensure the rights and entitlements of the seniors by providing or securing legal assistance.

BACKGROUND: (continued)

The Office of the County Counsel has approved this agreement as to form.
