SUBJECT: Ratify the Renewal Agreement, with Colorado River Senior Center FY 2004/05 for Senior Center Support in District 4.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached renewal agreement with Colorado River Senior Center.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: These agreements represent the last year of the four year 01-05 RFP contracting cycle.

The agreement with Colorado River Senior Center, covering the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$15,000, continues the services of the Senior Center for seniors in Fourth District.

Community Services and Senior Center Support maintains or improves the well being of older persons through the provision of necessary services in the community and the support of seniors.

The Office of the County Counsel has approved this agreement as to form.
