SUBJECT: Approve Agreement #04-35245 with the California State Department of Health, Pediatric Immunization Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve Agreement #04-35245 with the State of California Department of Health Services for the Pediatric Immunization Program for the performance period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005 for a total amount of \$543,651;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign eight (8) copies of the Agreement;
- 3) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign one (1) original Certification;
- 4) Direct the Clerk of the Board to return eight (8) original copies to the Community Health Agency Contract's Administration for further processing; and
- 5) Direct the Clerk of the Board to return one (1) signed original of the Certification to the Community Health Agency Contract Administration.

BACKGROUND: The Immunization Project was established to ensure adequate immunization of Riverside County children against vaccine-preventable childhood diseases. The goal of this program is to raise and maintain immunization rates of 90% or better for our children by age 2 years and 95% or better for our school-aged children kindergarten through grade 12.

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The national recommendations are age-appropriate immunizations for polio, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B, hepatitis A, chickenpox, Hemophilus influenza type B, and invasive pneumococcal disease. An allotment of \$160,000 was awarded for collaborative activities targeting WIC clients. As part of the collaborative activities parent education classes are given to stress the importance of timely immunizations for their children. This is a State mandated program.
