SUBJECT: Acceptance of Grant from the California Office of Emergency Services for Continuation of the Anti-Violence Against Women Program.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: (1) Accept the Anti-Violence Against Women Program Grant; (2) Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to execute the grant agreement in behalf of the County; and (3) Authorize the Board Chairman to sign the attached Certification of Assurance of Compliance.

BACKGROUND: Since April 1, 1999, the Probation Department has been operating a specialized domestic violence unit under a federally funded grant administered by the State. This unit was established in Adult Probation to supervise offenders of violent crimes against women in the Riverside-Moreno Valley area. The grant has been extended annually, and OCJP has now made another year of funding available for the period October 1, 2004, through September 30, 2005. However, due to a reduction in the Federal funds available, Riverside County's allocation was reduced from \$150,000 to \$124,969; this will require reduction of one partially funded probation officer, leaving two full time positions available for the program. The annual program cost of \$166,625, including a required match of \$41,656, is already budgeted. This will fund two probation officer positions and related costs for vehicles and other support. The program provides intensive supervision of no more than 40 cases per deputy, involving at least one weekly face-to-face contact, primarily in the field and unannounced. This agreement has been approved as to form by the Office of County Counsel.
