BACKGROUND: The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which certain Flood Control facilities, required as a condition of approval for Tract 30735 are to be constructed by the Developer and inspected, operated and maintained by the County and the District.

The Agreement is necessary to formalize the transfer of necessary rights-of-way and to provide for District construction inspection of the Eastvale-Fieldstream Court Storm Drain, Tract No. 30735.
