RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County), Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) and Barratt American, Inc. (Barratt) and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: In Fall 2003, Barratt American, Inc. requested the County to design and construct the Salt Creek-Leon Road Storm Drain facility with the Newport Road Extension Project.

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which Salt Creek-Leon Road Flood Control facilities, requested by Barratt, are to be funded by the Barratt, constructed by the County and inspected, operated and maintained by the County and the District.
