**SUBJECT:** Resolution No. 2004-400 for a Mid-Block Crosswalk on Inland Valley Drive; Resolution No. 413-568 for No-Stopping Zones on Inland Valley Drive, Murrieta area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board adopt Resolution No. 2004-400 for a Mid-Block Crosswalk and Resolution No. 413-568 for No-Stopping Zones, all on Inland Valley Drive in the Murrieta area as described in the attached resolutions.

**BACKGROUND:** The Transportation Department has received a request from the Facilities Coordinator at Kaiser Permanente Hospital requesting the installation of a mid-block crosswalk on Inland Valley Drive to better channelize pedestrians crossing the street between medical facilities on the east and west sides of Inland Valley Drive.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the traffic conditions on Inland Valley Drive and determined that a marked crosswalk will better channelize pedestrians to a specific location for orderly crossing of Inland Valley Drive. To improve sight distance at the crosswalk, and for ingress/egress of the nearby driveways, it was also determined that additional no-stopping zones are needed.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of this proposed mid-block crosswalk and No-Stopping Zones.

The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Temecula Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed mid-block crosswalk and No-Stopping Zones.

County Counsel has approved these resolutions.

13 Transportation Department is hereby directed to erect appropriate traffic control devices at said  
14 crossing.

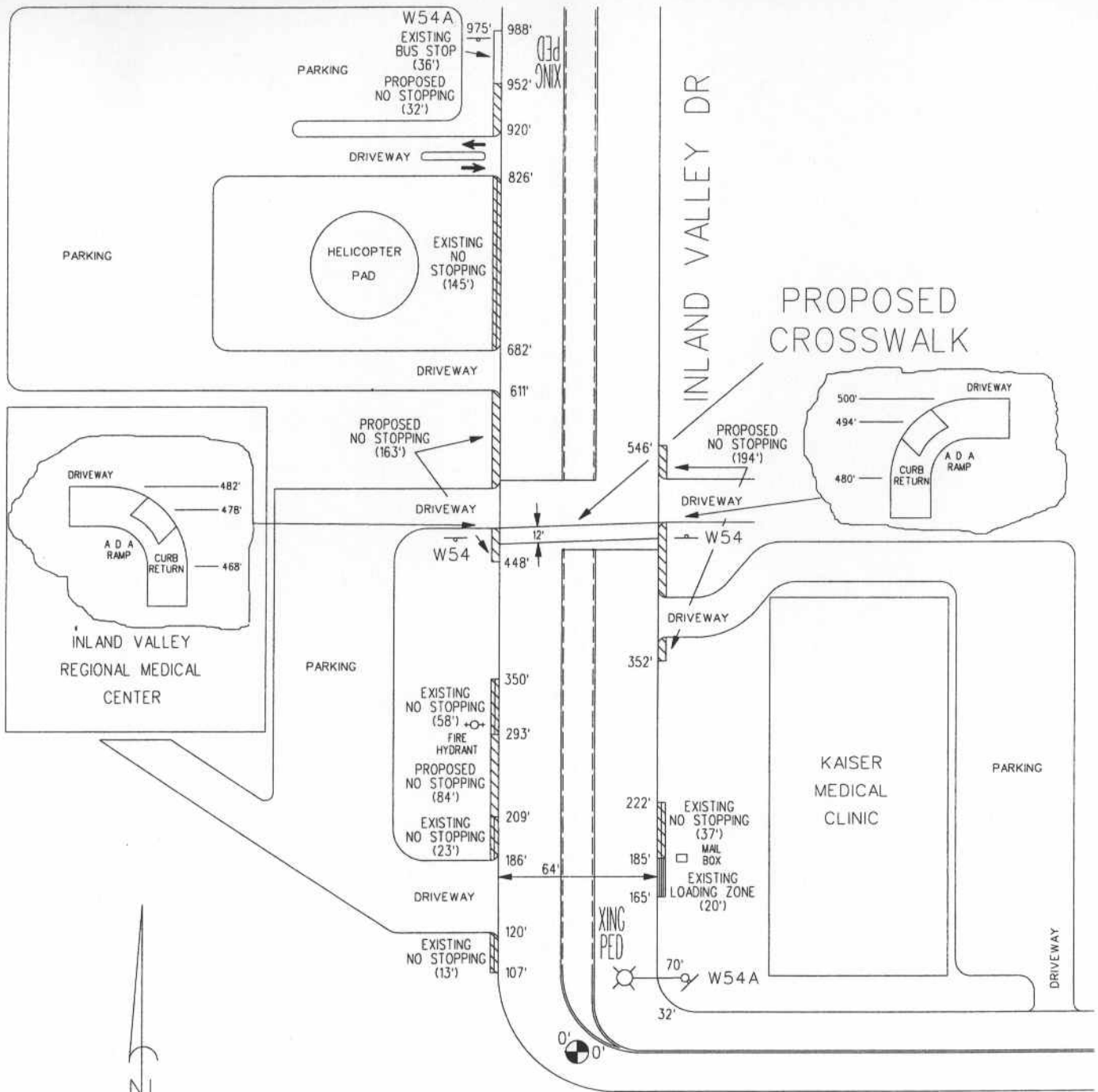

5 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of  
6 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on  
7 September 14, 2004, that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following No-  
8 Stopping Zones are hereby established in the Murrieta area:

9  
10 On the east side of Inland Valley Drive starting at a point 352 feet north of the  
11 centerline of Prielipp Road to a point 546 feet north of said centerline, a total  
12 distance of approximately 194 feet.

13  
14 On the west side of Inland Valley Drive starting at a point 209 feet north of the  
15 centerline of Prielipp Road to a point 293 feet north of said centerline, a total  
16 distance of approximately 84 feet.

19 On the west side of Inland Valley Drive starting at a point 448 feet north of the  
20 centerline of Prielipp Road to a point 611 feet north of said centerline, a total  
21 distance of approximately 163 feet.
