SUBJECT: Resolution 413-566 to Establish a "No-Parking for Certain Commercial Vehicles" Zone, County Service Area 122 (Mesa Verde area)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-566 to designate County Service Area (CSA) 122, Mesa Verde area, as a "No-Parking for Certain Commercial Vehicles" zone, and that the resolution be effective immediately.

BACKGROUND: Supervisor Wilson's office has received a number of requests from local residents in the Mesa Verde area regarding the prohibition of the parking of commercial vehicles, including big-rigs. It was requested that truck parking be prohibited on streets (both county-maintained and streets dedicated and accepted for public use) within CSA 122.

Staff reviewed the area and determined the Mesa Verde (CSA 122) area is residential in nature with narrow streets not suitable for the parking of large trucks.

It is recommended that truck parking prohibition be established for commercial vehicles having a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating of 10,000 pounds or more on all streets in CSA 122 as indicated on the attached resolution.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Blythe Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

6 WHEREAS, residential streets within County Service Area 122 (the Mesa
7 Verde area) in the County of Riverside are narrow residential streets with limited access
8 and are experiencing continuous and unresolvable problems relating to the parking of
9 commercial vehicles therein; and,

11 WHEREAS, County Ordinance No. 413 prohibits the parking or standing
12 of certain commercial vehicles within a residential area designated by resolution of the
13 Board of Supervisors; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
16 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
17 September 14, 2004, that the following parking restriction is hereby established in
18 County Service Area 122 (the Mesa Verde area), effective September 14,

23 weight rating of 10,000 pounds or more established on the streets described below.
