BACKGROUND: These agreements represent the last year of the four year 01-05 RFP contracting cycle.

The agreement with Inland Agency, covering the period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, in the reimbursable amount of \$214,077, continues the **Health Insurance Counseling & Advocacy Program (HICAP)** that provides counseling and advocacy for Medicare Beneficiaries and Community Education to the public at large.
