**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Third Amendment to Agreement with First Chance Y-Chow, Inc. for HIV Education and Prevention Services DPH02K.031

**BACKGROUND** (continued): First Chance Y-Chow, Inc. (FCYC) has provided HIV Prevention services since 1996. FCYC has the facility and experienced staff needed to provide optimum educational services for the residents of Riverside County. On August 27, 2002 the Board of Supervisor executed the First Amendment to extend the period of performance through June 30, 2003 for the amount of \$31,626. The second Amendment increased funding to \$48,758 and extended the period of performance through June 30, 2004. This Third Amendment will increase the contract amount by \$2,446 for a total contract amount of \$51,204 from California Department of Health Office of AIDS. Funds for this increase are a result of previous allocated funds for Fiscal Year 03/04.
