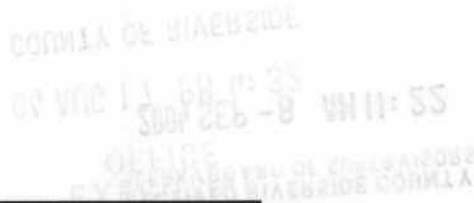

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

IEHP, as a Local Initiative Medi-Cal Management Care Plan, is required to coordinate public health services with the Public Health Departments of Riverside and San Bernardino Counties. Therefore, IEHP is contracting with the Community Health Agency Department of Public Health Nutrition Services Branch to provide a Diabetes Management Program for its members. This amendment provides changes in the Attachment A, Scope of Work, and adjustments to Attachment B, Schedule of Fees, to reflect the increase costs for services provided.

On June 30, 2004, this amendment was received from IEHP and preparation of this Form 11 began.
