BACKGROUND : The City of Fontana and the City of Ontario City Councils have approved and signed the maintenance Agreement with the County of Riverside wherein reimbursement will be provided to the County for each City's proportionate share of the associated maintenance service costs related to the traffic signal and safety lighting

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the agreement as to form.

Financial Data

Currently, the costs associated with the maintenance of the above-mentioned traffic signal and safety lighting location is covered 100% by State Highway User Tax Funds. Approval of the Agreement with the City of Fontana and the City of Ontario would offset 50% of the existing maintenance costs with 25% of the funding being provided by each City. The Transportation Department recommends approval of the Agreement.
