BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health Nutrition Services Branch has received a grant award from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC) in the amount of \$1,721,984. Under this fifth year of funding, Nutrition Services will provide the following:

- a) Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Supplemental Nutrition Program will be expanded to serve more pregnant women and children under the age of 5 years.
- b) The program will increase the number of pregnant women who will receive accurate and reliable information on the importance and how to initiate breastfeeding by maintaining and expanding breastfeeding displays in doctor's offices countywide.
- c) Newly delivered mothers will receive information; support and help for breastfeeding in the immediate postpartum period via a 24 hour help line.
- d) Nutrition education and informational tool kits will be provided to new child care providers and food security sites across Riverside County.
- e) The program will also provide ongoing development and distribution of nutrition and physical activity promotion lesson plans, which promote healthy eating and physical activity for children through age 5.

On July 15, 2004, this agreement was received from RCCFC and preparation of this Form 11 began.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
