SUBJECT: Recommendation for Distribution of Excess Proceeds for Tax Sale No. 163, Item 772.
Last assessed to: Paul I. Miller, a single man and Chase Hill Corporation, a California Corporation, each as to an undivided 1/2 interest, as tenants in common.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the claim from Paul I. Miller, last assessee for payment of excess proceeds resulting from the Tax Collector's public auction sale associated with parcel 657181037-4;
- 2) Deny the claim from Chase Hill Corporation, a California Corporation, last assessee;
- 3) Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to issue a warrant to Paul I. Miller, in the amount of \$1,155.43 no sooner than ninety days from the date of this order, unless pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675, an appeal has been filed in Superior Court.

BACKGROUND: In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the March 11, 2002 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded May 3, 2002. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on June 3, 2002, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.

The Treasurer-Tax Collector has received two claims for excess proceeds:

- 1) Claim from Paul I. Miller based on a Grant Deed recorded January 5, 1989 as Instrument No. 3335.
- 2) Claim from Chase Hill Corp., a California Corporation based on a Grant Deed recorded January 5, 1989 as Instrument No. 3335.

Pursuant to Section 4675 (a) & (b) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, it is the recommendation of this office that Paul I. Miller, last assessee be awarded excess proceeds in the amount of \$1,155.43. The claim from Chase Hill Corp., a California Corporation is denied since no supporting documentation was provided. The excess proceeds in the amount of \$1,155.42 will remain unclaimed. The Tax Collector requests approval of the above recommended motion.
