**SUBJECT:** Closure of Edom Hill Landfill

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Receive and file notice of the proposed closure of the Edom Hill Landfill to the public on November 30, 2004.

**BACKGROUND:** The Waste Management Department (WMD) entered into a lease agreement November 5, 2002 with Waste Management of the Desert (WMD) for the permitting, design, construction and operation of a solid waste transfer station on the Edom Hill Landfill site in anticipation of the landfill reaching its full capacity. WMD has provided WMD with a schedule indicating the new transfer station will be ready to process and transfer waste on November 30, 2004. Based on this, WMD plans to close the landfill to the public on the same day. Hours of operation at the transfer station will be Monday through Saturday, from 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM and on Sunday from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM for self-haulers only.

As required by current regulations, the closure date will be posted at the landfill no less than 60 days prior to November 30 and published in local newspapers no less than 30 days prior to November 30. WMD has already notified the haulers/account holders, cities, CVAG, Coachella Transfer Station JPA, the Local Task Force, regulatory agencies, LIUNA, and SEIU.
