**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

The Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation has awarded funding to the Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health, Disease Control for the operation of the Healthy Children Connection (HCC) Program in eastern Riverside County. This award is for the third year of funding.

Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health, will contract with Palo Verde Unified School District and Catholic Charities to provide HCC services in the Palo Verde Valley. The program utilizes the promotora model which involves recruitment, training and utilization of community volunteers as peer health promoters to provide door-to-door outreach to families promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of young children. The award also funds a part-time Public Health Nurse (PHN) who provides home visitation to HCC clients as part of case management activities.

The funds are to be distributed as follows:

- a) \$27,358 –Allocated for the Department of Public Health for PHN services; and
- b) \$11,318 – Allocated to Catholic Charities for the services of part-time personnel for assisting clients with social needs; and
- c) \$63,018– Allocated to Palo Verde Unified School District for outreach and case management services.

This agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
