SUBJECT: Resolution 413-563 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Harvill Avenue, Perris area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-563 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Harvill Avenue in the Perris area, as described in attached Resolution 413-563.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department received a request from the Sheriff's Department for a No-Stopping Zone on Harvill Avenue.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and observed vehicles parked adjacent to the curb, blocking the number two traffic lane (which is 16-foot wide) on Harvill Avenue.

The proposed no-stopping zone will improve traffic flow and safety on Harvill Avenue.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of the No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

8 Stopping Zone is hereby established in the Perris area:

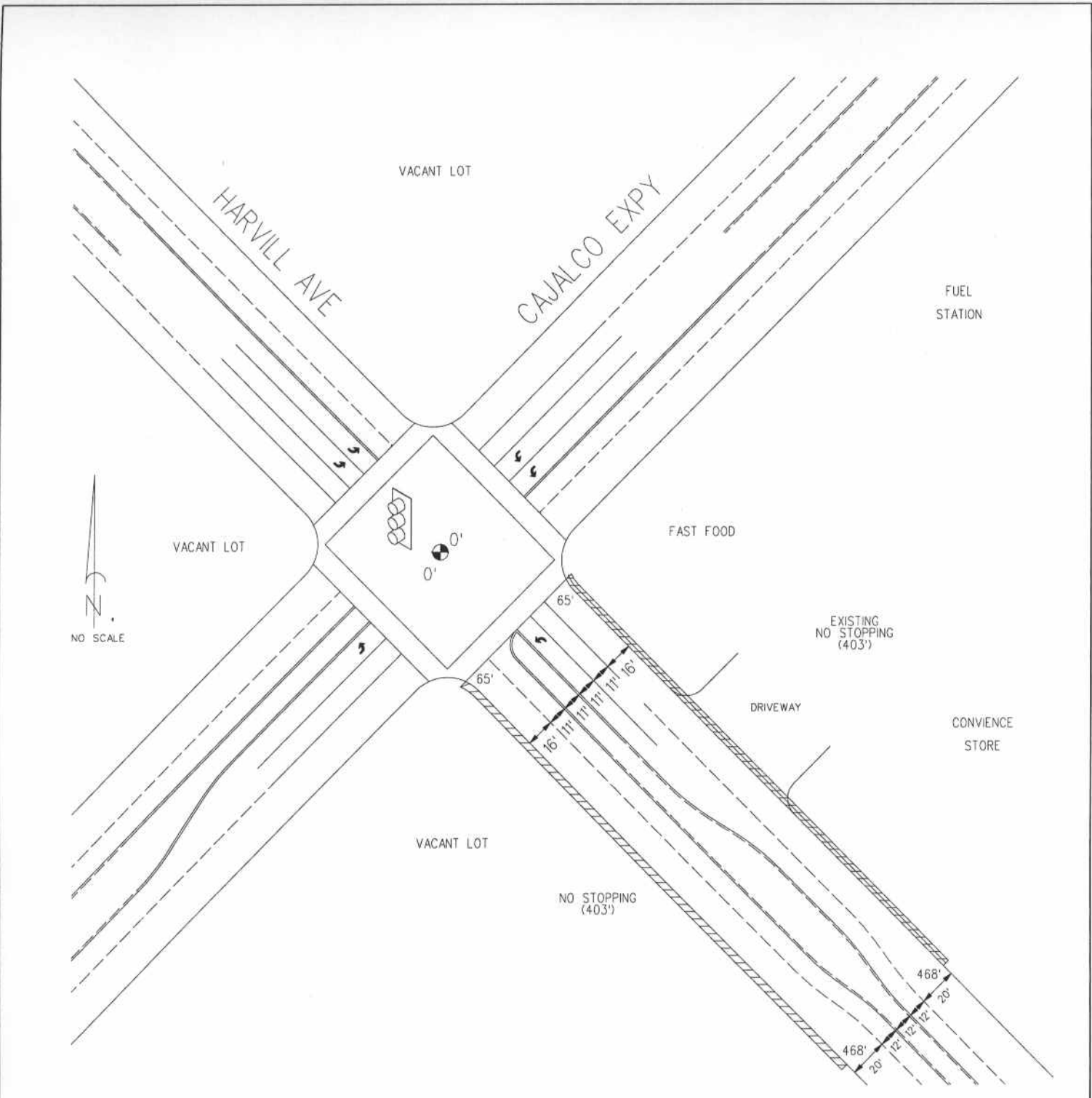
