SUBJECT: Resolution 413-572 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Elizabeth Lane, Murrieta area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-572 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Elizabeth Lane in the Murrieta area, as described in attached Resolution 413-572.

BACKGROUND: The issue of a no-stopping zone came up at a Planning Commission meeting in 2003 due to potential impacts on a proposed development in the southeast corner of Prielipp Road and Elizabeth Lane. Residents asked that parking be prohibited on both sides of Elizabeth Lane south of Prielipp Road. At the Board of Supervisors meeting on June 17, 2003 (Item 16.6), Supervisor Buster requested that Transportation Department staff review the need for such a zone. The development was subsequently approved and is currently under construction.

Transportation Department reviewed this location in the field and determined that a no-stopping zone on the west side of Elizabeth Lane is appropriate to provide sufficient street width to address vehicle access, including emergency vehicles. Prohibition of parking on the east side of Elizabeth Lane adjacent to the new apartment complex will be reviewed after the apartment complex is occupied.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of the No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Temecula Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

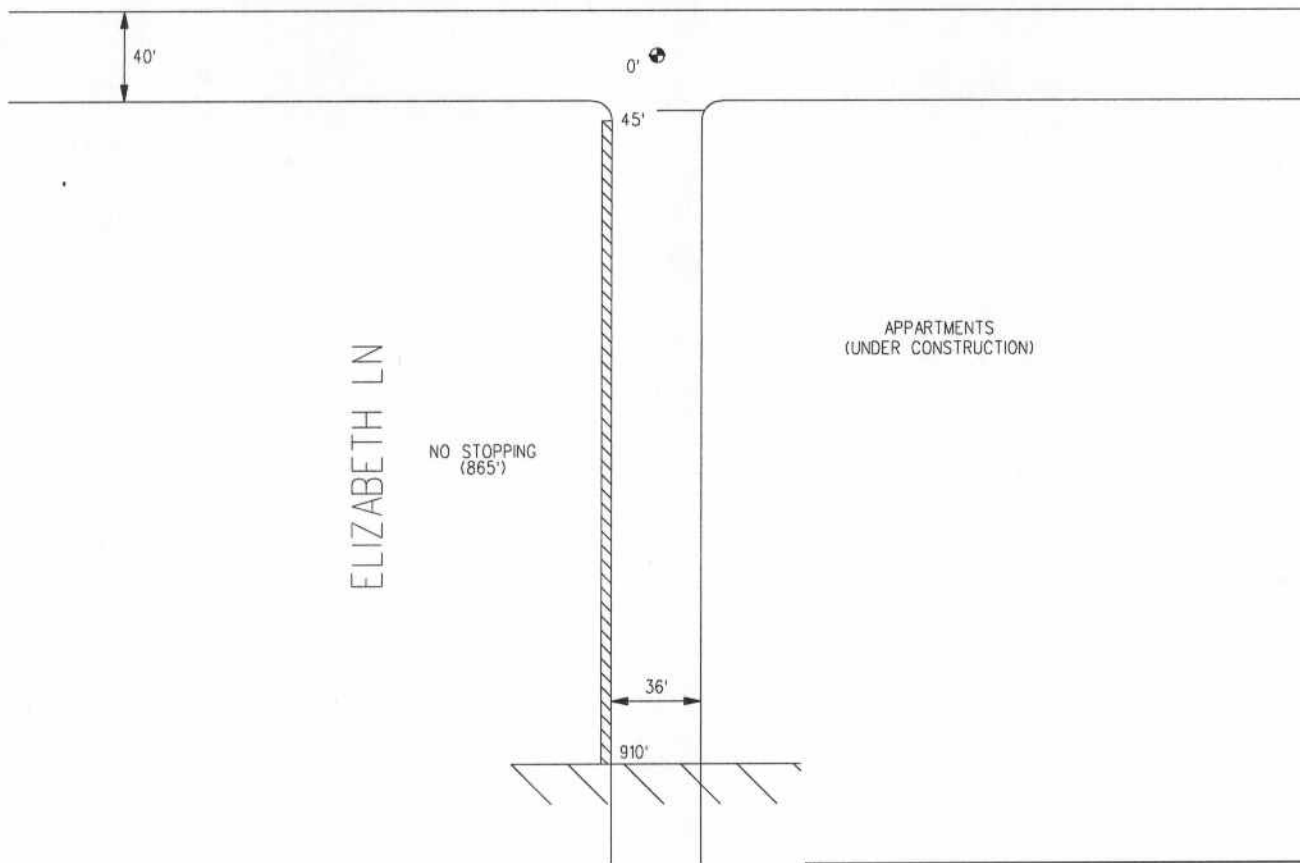
