**SUBJECT:** Approval of Transfer of the Larson Justice Center in Indio to the State of California, under the Judicial Council of California, related to the Trial Court Facilities Act of 2002 (SB1732)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve in-concept the transfer of responsibility of the Larson Justice Center to the State of California; and,
- 2) Approve the attached Proclamation in support of the transfer to be presented to Chief Justice George at the October 21, 2004 Transfer Ceremony for the Larson Justice Center.

Departmental Concurrence

**BACKGROUND:** The Trial Court Facilities Act of 2002, SB1732, was enacted to provide for the transfer of responsibility for funding and operation of trial court facilities from the counties to the Judicial Council of California. The County of Riverside was selected by the Judicial Council as a pilot county in the state for implementing SB1732. On October 21, 2004 a ceremony will be held at the Larson Justice Center in Indio to signify the first court building transfer in California. The Executive Office, Facilities Management, County Counsel, Sheriff and the Superior Court cooperated with the Judicial Council to develop plans for transferring the Larson Justice Center in Indio.
