SUBJECT: Cooperative Agreement for Roadway and Traffic Signal Improvements at the intersection of Foothill Parkway/El Cerrito Road and Bedford Canyon Road, Corona area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the City of Corona for the construction of certain road improvements in connection with acquisition of right-of-way, the installation of a traffic signal and the realignment of Bedford Canyon Road at the junction of El Cerrito Road, and authorize the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute the agreement.

BACKGROUND: The County Transportation Department and the City of Corona are cooperating on the construction of certain road improvements. The road improvements are located within the County, and the City and County believe it is to the mutual benefit of each party that the proposed Bedford Canyon Road be realigned further away from the El Cerrito/I-15 Interchange and that a traffic signal be constructed. The realignment of Bedford Canyon Road and the traffic signal will improve the safety and operation of the intersection.

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BACKGROUND: (continued)

Because both agencies will benefit from the road improvements, both parties have agreed to share in the costs associated with the design and construction of the road improvements. The City of Corona will be the lead agency for the proposed project.

The total cost of the project is estimated to be approximately \$955,670. The City's share of the project is estimated at \$230,000. The County's share of the cost is \$725,670, which is funded by Western County Traffic Signal Funds of the Development Impact Fees (DIF).

The City's share of the project cost covers the cost of the traffic signal. The City has agreed to participate in the cost of the overall project, which is located within the County, since it also benefits residents in the City as part of overall improvements to the Foothill Parkway corridor.

This project requires the purchase of two home sites and the relocation of one home. This agreement gives the City, as the lead agency, the authority to purchase property and do the relocation on behalf of the County.

Upon completion and acceptance of the traffic signal, the County will maintain the proposed signal. The annual maintenance cost of the signal is estimated at \$4,500, which will be funded by gas tax.

After the Board of Supervisors approves the agreement, the City of Corona will execute the agreement and proceed with the project.
