BACKGROUND: (Continued).

Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is contracting with Valley Health System for the Healthy Children Connection program, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. Valley Health System offers services to clients in Districts 1, 3, and 5. This includes assistance with applications for medical insurance and other entitlement program. The Department of Public Health receives funding from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission (First 5) and subcontracts with Valley Health System for services.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level. Exhibits A and B and Attachment A have been modified for the new performance period of July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005, and Exhibit D has been added.
