**SUBJECT:** Approval of Resolution #2004-442 Authorizing the District Attorney's Office to Submit a Proposal to the California Department of Insurance

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution #2004-442 which authorizes the District Attorney to submit and sign a grant application to the California Department of Insurance (DOI).

**BACKGROUND:** The Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud Program grant awarded under the provision of section 1872.8 of the California Insurance Code and administered through DOI is designed to assist in the enhanced investigation and prosecution of workers' compensation fraud cases. This ongoing program requires Board Resolution for the District Attorney to receive funding. The Resolution for Workers' Compensation is effective for a three- year period beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2007. The Resolution has been reviewed and approved as form by County Counsel. The award for the renewed grant period July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005 is \$650,000. No County match is required for this grant program. The award amount for the Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud grant is included in the department's current fiscal year budget.

4 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
5 COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REGARDING  
6 THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE FRAUD PROGRAM

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated  
9 Investigation and Prosecution of Workers' Compensation Insurance Fraud to be funded in part from funds  
10 made available through California Insurance Code Section 1872.83, California Code of Regulations  
11 Subchapter 9, Article 3, Section 2698.55 and administered by the California Department of Insurance  
12 (hereinafter referred to as "DOI"); now, therefore,

13 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,  
14 State of California, in regular session assembled on October 26, 2004, that the District  
15 Attorney of the County of Riverside, State of California is authorized, on its behalf, to submit the attached  
16 proposal to the DOI and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
17 Riverside the attached Grant Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract,  
19 including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the  
20 authorizing agency. The State of California and DOI disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period  
22 beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2007.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant  
24 expenditures controlled by this body.

25 IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to hiring freezes.
