BACKGROUND:

Rebuilding Together Riverside (Norco Area) requested funding from the City of Norco in the amount of \$15,000 to provide home modification/rehabilitation to low-income families/elderly/disabled homeowners. The City has reviewed the program goals and approved funding for this project.

The program is administered by a volunteer board of directors with no paid staff. A site committee visits and reviews each applicant and, according to need recommends the participant to the Rebuilding Together Riverside Board of Directors for final approval. "Rebuilding Day" is set for the last Saturday in April. CDBG funds will be used to hire direct service staff, and to purchase building materials.
