RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreement #DC1756-00 between the City of Riverside (City) and the Department of Public Social Services-Department of Community Action (DPSS-DCA) to fund three Project L.E.A.D. (Linking Education, Advocacy and Development) mentor/tutor members, for the term July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, not to exceed \$9,403;
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign any Amendments which do not exceed the Board-approved allocation;
- 3) Authorize the Director of DPSS to sign assurances, exhibits, and reports made under the Agreement; and
- 4) Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

On March 9, 2004 (Agenda #3.30) and May 11, 2004 (Agenda #3.24), the Board approved the 2004 Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) Agreement and Amendment establishing and increasing the allocation which includes funds for the Project L.E.A.D. program. The City approved the application DPSS-DCA submitted for sponsorship requesting funding for three Project L.E.A.D. mentor/tutors. These three mentor/tutors would be placed in three Riverside Unified School District middle schools during the 2004/2005 school year.

Project L.E.A.D. trains mentor/tutors to serve students enrolled in after-school programs at various middle schools in the County of Riverside. Project L.E.A.D. teams provide cross-generational mentoring/tutoring through character development activities such as recreation, crafts, art, music, computers, and academic course work. Mentor/tutors are trained to teach youth personal life skills (anger management, cultural tolerance, and civic commitment). Riverside Unified School District reported that 80% of the youth indicated positive lifestyle changes as a result of the after school program. Project L.E.A.D. mentor/tutors engage youth in enrichment activities and safety training three hours per day, four days per week.

The Director of DPSS requests that the Board approve the attached Agreement between the City and DPSS-DCA, for the term July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, not to exceed \$9,403.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: No County General Funds will be required.
