SUBJECT: Allocation of Funds for the Valley Way/Armstrong Road Improvement Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Directors approve the allocation of \$600,000 for relocation payments to eligible displacees affected by the Valley Way/Armstrong Road Improvement Project, ("Project").

BACKGROUND: On September 9, 2003, the Board of Supervisors approved the Transportation Improvement Program which included the Project. The Project includes the construction of sidewalks, curb and gutter, straightening of the existing curve for better line of sight, and the widening of the road from two lanes to four lanes with a center turn lane. These improvements will increase safety for both pedestrians and vehicular travel.

Acquisition of the necessary right of way needed to complete the construction of these road improvements will require the displacement of some occupants. The Redevelopment Agency will be providing eligible displacees with relocation benefits pursuant to current relocation laws.
