SUBJECT: Resolution 413-565 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Porter Avenue, Woodcrest area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-565 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Porter Avenue in the Woodcrest area, as described in attached Resolution 413-565.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department received a request for a No-Stopping Zone on the east side of Porter Avenue just north of its intersection with Van Buren Boulevard, which is signalized.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and observed customers of the adjacent nursery parking their vehicles on Porter Avenue and causing impedance of traffic from Van Buren onto Porter, especially for large commercial vehicles.

The proposed no-stopping zone will improve operation and safety of the intersection of Van Buren Boulevard and Porter Avenue, as well as the sight distance for traffic exiting the nursery driveway on Porter Avenue.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of the No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

8 Stopping Zone is hereby established in the Woodcrest area:

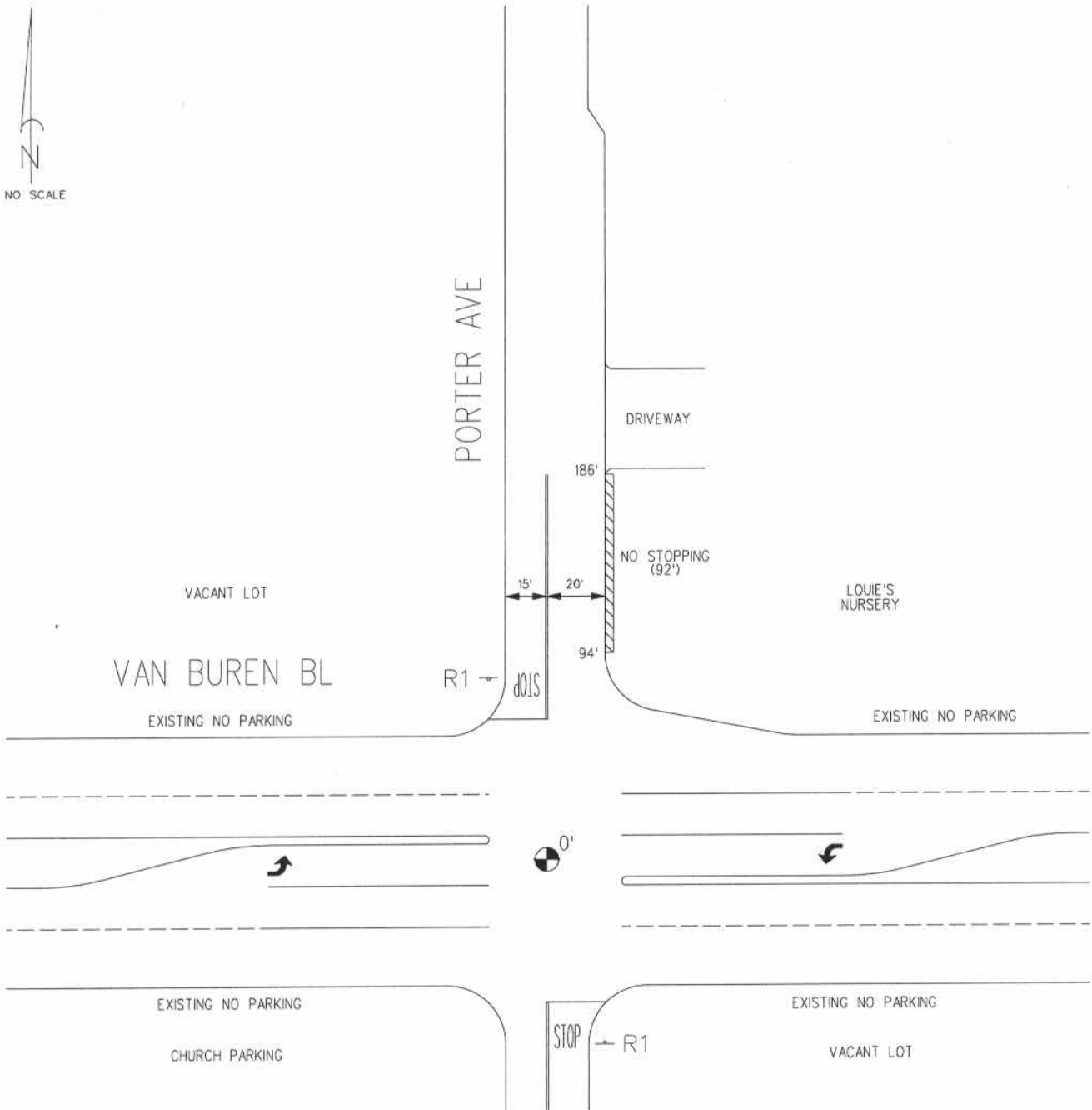
