**BACKGROUND:**

Desert AIDS Project (DAP) has provided HIV Education and Prevention Services since 1996. DAP has the facility and experienced staff needed for the optimum provision of education services for the residents of Riverside County. The State of California has increased Education and Prevention funding allocation to Riverside County; which is being passed on to sub-contractors.

This Sixth Amendment is to allocate funding to DAP, for HIV Education and Prevention Services for the following target populations: Men to Men; intravenous drug users; People with Addictions; and Youth.

The total amount of \$119,680 represents a partial year. A Request for Proposal (RFP) is in process for HIV/AIDS Education and Prevention services and is expected to close before December 31, 2004.
