**BACKGROUND:** (Continued).

Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is contracting with Catholic Charities for the Healthy Children Connection Program, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. The Department of Public Health receives funding from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission (First 5) and subcontracts with Catholic Charities for services in the Coachella Valley (District 4).

The Regional Access Project (RAP) Foundation has awarded funds to the Department of Public Health to serve the Palo Verde Valley. The Department of Public Health is contracting with Catholic Charities for services of the Healthy Children Connection Program in the Palo Verde Valley as well. Due to a decrease in funding for Fiscal Year 04/05, each partner received an equitable reduction in funds. A meeting was held with the manager for Catholic Charities to renegotiate the contract. The expected outcomes and level of service were adjusted to be consistent with the level of funding.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level. Exhibits A, A-1 and B-1 and attachments A and A-1 have been modified for the new performance period, and Exhibit D has been added.

This amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
