SUBJECT: AGREEMENTS WITH COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COUNTY'S INTERNET BASED HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (HMIS)

BACKGROUND:

On July 13, 2004, (Agenda Reference 3.35), the Board executed a Grant Agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to implement and manage the Homeless Management Information System and authorized the Director of DPSS to administer the HMIS program with service providers.

As a result, DPSS, with the concurrence of HUD, is implementing the commercially developed Internet based HMIS system that can be regularly updated according to HUD's most current specifications and requirements. This new Internet based HMIS system will allow the County to more effectively assess homeless needs, allocate resources, and coordinate services through its enhanced tracking and reporting capabilities. The attached Master Agreement sets forth the roles and responsibilities of both DPSS and the service providers who will be using the HMIS system.
