**SUBJECT:** Allocation of Third District Developer Agreement Funds to the Quail Valley Volunteer Fire Company (VFC) and Riverside County Fire Department.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board join with me to:

- 1) Approve the use of \$75,000 of Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund No. 30558-1103500000 to give to the Quail Valley Volunteer Fire Company for a new squad for the Quail Valley Fire Station;
- 2) Direct the Executive Office to process payment of \$75,000 from Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund 30558-1103500000 to the Quail Valley Volunteer Fire Company;
- 3) Approve the use of \$24,000 of Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund No. 30558-1103500000 to give to Riverside County Fire Department Fund No. 10000-2700200000-767220 for the purchase of six (6) Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs) to be used by the Quail Valley Fire Station;
- 4) Direct the Executive Office to process payment of \$24,000 from Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund 30558-1103500000 to the Riverside County Fire Department Fund No. 10000-2700200000-767220;
- 5) Direct the Auditor-Controller to increase the Riverside County Fire Department Fund No. 10000-2700200000-767220 by \$24,000.

**BACKGROUND:** Our volunteer fire companies throughout the county are an invaluable asset to our fire department and our constituents. One of these companies is the Quail Valley Volunteer Fire Company (VFC). They are located in an area that is experiencing rapid growth and their calls are increasing along with the population.

It is vital that we provide our volunteers and our fire department with the facilities and equipment to perform their critical function. One of the needs of the Quail Valley VFC is for a new squad for their fire station and for six (6) new Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBAs). The cost for the squad and some replacement equipment is \$75,000. The cost for the SCBAs is \$4,000 each for a total of \$24,000. I want to help the Quail Valley area, this fire station and volunteer company with this endeavor and I urge the Board to join with me to support this request.
