SUBJECT: Allocation of Third District Developer Agreement Funds to the Sun City Library for carpet and furniture replacement or re-upholstering.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board join with me to:

- 1) Approve the transfer of \$44,500 of Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund No. 30558-1103500000 to the Sun City Library for carpet and to replace or re-upholster furniture.
- 2) Direct the Executive Office to process total payment of \$44,500 from Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund 30558-1103500000 to the Sun City Library, Fund No 522310-21200-11015000000
- 3) Direct the Auditor-Controller to increase the Sun City Library budget Fund No 522310-21200-1101500000 by \$44,500

BACKGROUND: The Sun City Library is one of the most heavily used libraries in the Riverside County Library System. The public borrows approximately 160,000 library books and other items from this facility every year. This is more items than nearly any other library in the system. Nearly 140,000 persons visit the Sun City Library each year. The library opened in 1994 and has never been re-carpeted and the furniture has never been replaced or re-upholstered. Because the Sun City Library is one of the busiest library branches in the county, with 10 years of heavy use the carpet and furniture is in dire need of replacement. The cost of replacing the carpet is \$20,000, relocation of book collection for installation of carpet is \$10,000 and the furniture replacement or re-upholstering is \$14,500 for a total of \$44,500. I urge the Board to join with me to support this request.
