SUBJECT: Construction of Interchange Landscaping Improvements, Interstate 10 at Monterey Avenue and Interstate 10 at Washington Street, Palm Desert area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of interchange landscape improvements at the Interstate 10 at Washington Street and Interstate 10 at Monterey Avenue freeway interchanges in the Palm Desert area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, December 1, 2004, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The 2004-2005 Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject landscaping improvements. The landscaping design is consistent with the report entitled "The I-10 corridor in the Coachella Valley: Gateway to the Desert Communities, Regional Design Guidelines and Highway Art Program", as prepared for the Coachella Valley Association of Governments (CVAG).

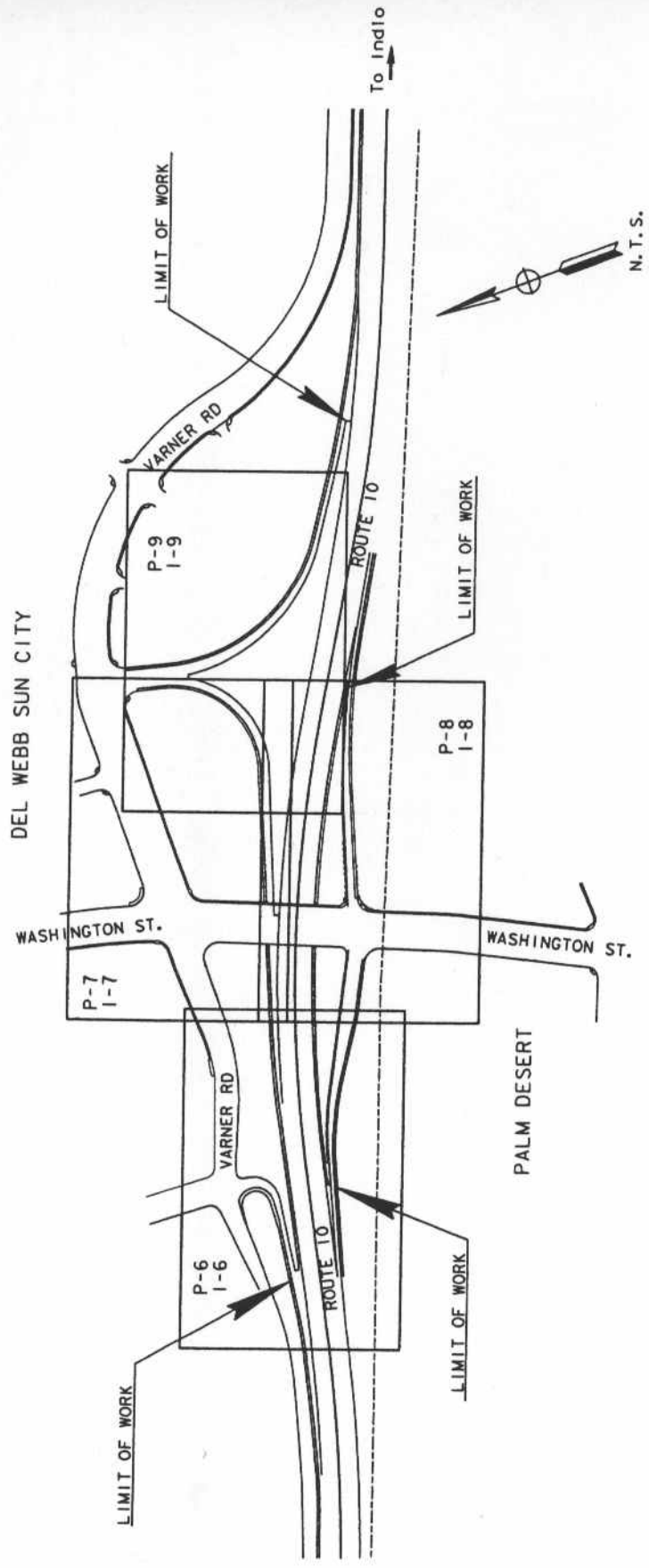

The primary funding for the project is Federal TEA funds for which the Transportation Department has successfully applied. Maintenance costs will be shared among the County, Caltrans, the City of Palm Desert, the City of Rancho Mirage, the City of La Quinta and the City of Indian Wells under the terms of two cooperative agreements which are in development, and which are anticipated to be executed prior to the award of the construction contract.

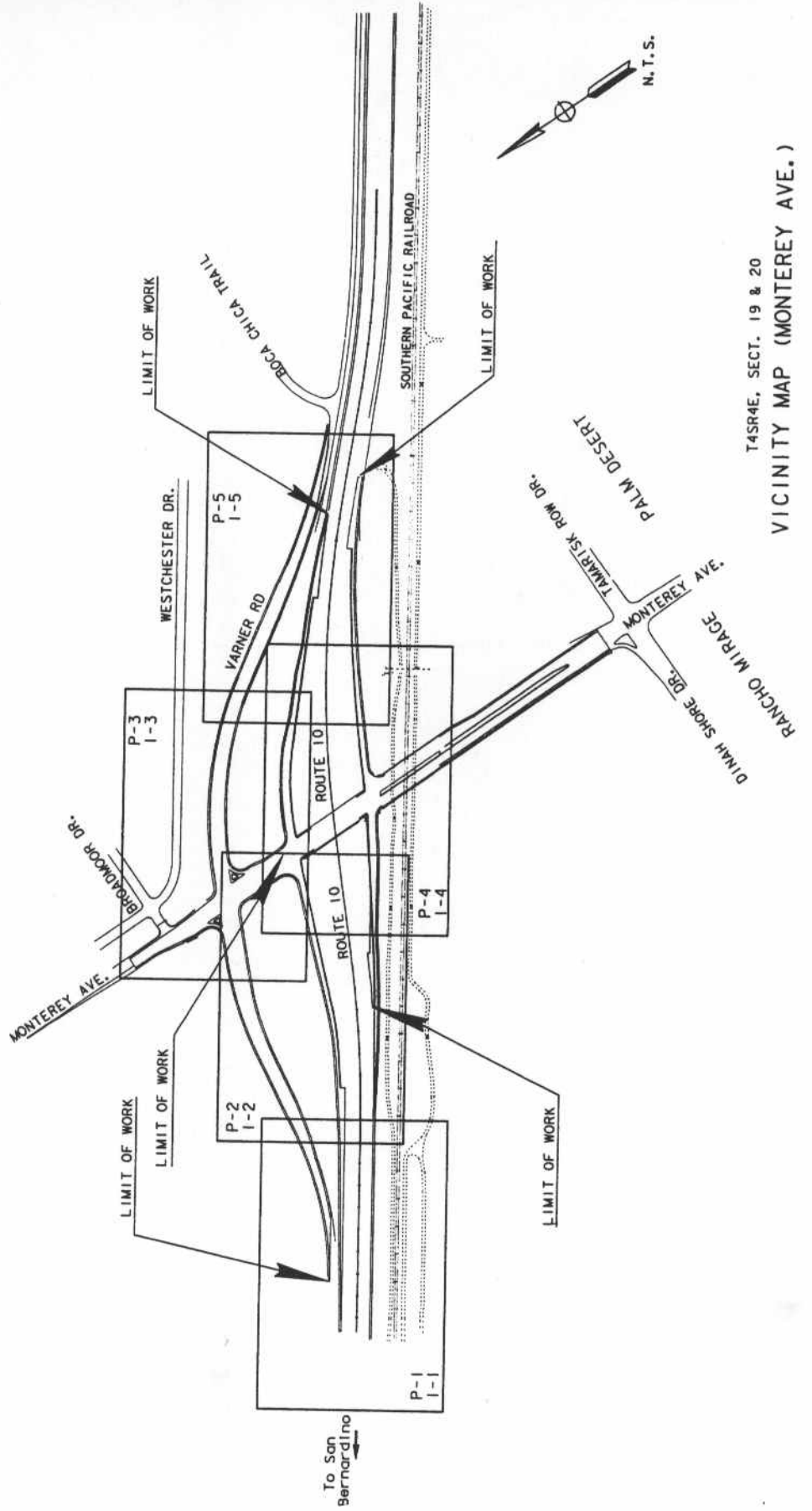
The State of California will assume maintenance responsibility for the improvements after 4 years for the Interstate 10 at Monterey Avenue interchange, and after 20 years for the Interstate 10 at Washington Street interchange.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. Environmental clearance is complete.
