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BACKGROUND: This award is funded through the State of California Department of Health Services for the Collaborative Augmentation Project in order to support and encourage nutritional and physical activities and wellness messages in the work place. The target population for this funding is Riverside County and San Bernardino County workplace population at or below the 185% poverty level. Riverside County will distribute the tool kits to community worksites within Riverside and San Bernardino County that employ the target population.
