**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and the Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health for Oral Health Care and Pharmacy (Contract 04-152).

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and the County of Riverside Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health in the amount of \$108,000; from March 1, 2004 to February 28, 2005; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to sign five (5) originals of said Agreement on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:** The Ryan White CARE Act was enacted in 1990 to provide Federal funding for comprehensive health and social services for persons living with the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). The Federal Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) provides funding through Title I of the Ryan White CARE Act to areas disproportionately affected by the HIV epidemic.

**Subject:** Ratify the Agreement between San Bernardino County, Department of Health and the Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health for Oral Health Care and Pharmacy (Contract 04-152).

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### **BACKGROUND:** (Continued)

Funds from this Agreement provide oral health care, and expand the number of prescription or over-the-counter medications available to improve the quality of life or prevent the deterioration of health in low-income persons living with HIV in Riverside County.

People living with HIV disease require regular oral health evaluations to reduce the complication from HIV disease. The funds will pay for preventive, as well as restorative, care for eligible clients.

Many people living with HIV disease require extensive medication to maintain a healthy and productive quality of life. Funds from this grant will provide both prescription and over the counter medications to patients who meet the eligibility criteria for services.

**JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY:** The Department of Public Health recently received this agreement from San Bernardino County. This Form 11 and attachments were subsequently submitted through the County's approval process.
