SUBJECT: Approval of Acquisition and Temporary Construction Agreement for the Valley Way/Armstrong Road Improvement Project.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Directors:

1. Approve the Acquisition and Temporary Construction Agreement for County's Parcel Nos. 0386-008A and 0386-008B from Carmen Vasquez;
2. Authorize and direct Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement; and
3. Authorize and direct the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, to administer all actions or sign any related documents necessary to complete this transaction.

BACKGROUND: On August 9, 2003, the Board of Supervisors approved the Transportation Improvement Program which included the Valley Way project. The Redevelopment Agency has been negotiating with property owners for the acquisition of lands necessary for the construction of said improvements. These improvements include sidewalks, curbs and gutters, straightening of the existing curve for better line of sight, and the widening of the road from two lanes to four lanes with a center turn lane. These improvements will increase safety for both pedestrians and vehicular travel.

BACKGROUND (continued)

Guided by Government Code Section 7267: "In order to encourage and expedite the acquisition and relieve congestion in the courts, to assume consistent treatment for owners in the public programs, and to promote public land acquisition practices, public entities shall, to the greatest extent practicable be guided by the provision of Section 7267.1: 'The public entity shall make every reasonable effort to acquire expeditiously real property by negotiation'."
