SUBJECT: Resolution 413-559 to Establish a No-Parking Zone and No-Stopping Zones, Lemon Street, Wildomar area

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board adopt Resolution 413-559 to establish a No-Parking Zone and No-Stopping Zones on Lemon Street in the Wildomar area, as described in attached Resolution 413-559.

Also, that the Board rescind Resolution 413-479 for a No-Stopping Zone on the north side of Lemon Street.

BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Department was contacted by the principal of the Jean Hayman Elementary School who was concerned about traffic congestion and conflicts between vehicles and pedestrians.

Transportation Department staff met with the principal and conducted a field review of the site. It was determined that the proposed No-Parking Zone and No-Stopping Zones will facilitate the movement of traffic, prevent parked vehicles from blocking pedestrian and vehicular access, and improve sight distance at the school crosswalk.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of these zones.

The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Temecula Area office of the CHP regarding the proposed zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

4 ESTABLISHING A NO-PARKING ZONE AND NO-STOPPING ZONES
5 IN THE WILDOMAR AREA

6 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors,
7 County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on December 7, 2004,
8 that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following no-parking zone and no-stopping zones are
9 hereby established in the Wildomar area:

10 No-Parking Zone

11 On the south side of Lemon Street starting at a point 955 feet east of the centerline of
12 Mission Trail to a point 1,155 feet east of said centerline, a total distance of
13 approximately 200 feet.

14 No-Stopping Zones

15 On the north side of Lemon Street starting at a point 505 feet west of the centerline of
16 Valencia Street to a point 535 feet west of said centerline, a total distance of
17 approximately 30 feet.

18
19 On the south side of Lemon Street starting 1,155 feet east of the centerline of Mission
20 Trail to a point 1,220 feet east of said centerline, a total distance of approximately 65
21 feet.

22
23 On the south side of Lemon Street starting at a point 65 feet west of the centerline of
24 Valencia Street to a point 65 feet east of said centerline, a total distance of
25 approximately 130 feet.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that Resolution No.
2 413-479, heretofore adopted by this Board of Supervisors on August 14, 2001, for a no-
3 stopping zone on the north side of Lemon Street is hereby rescinded.

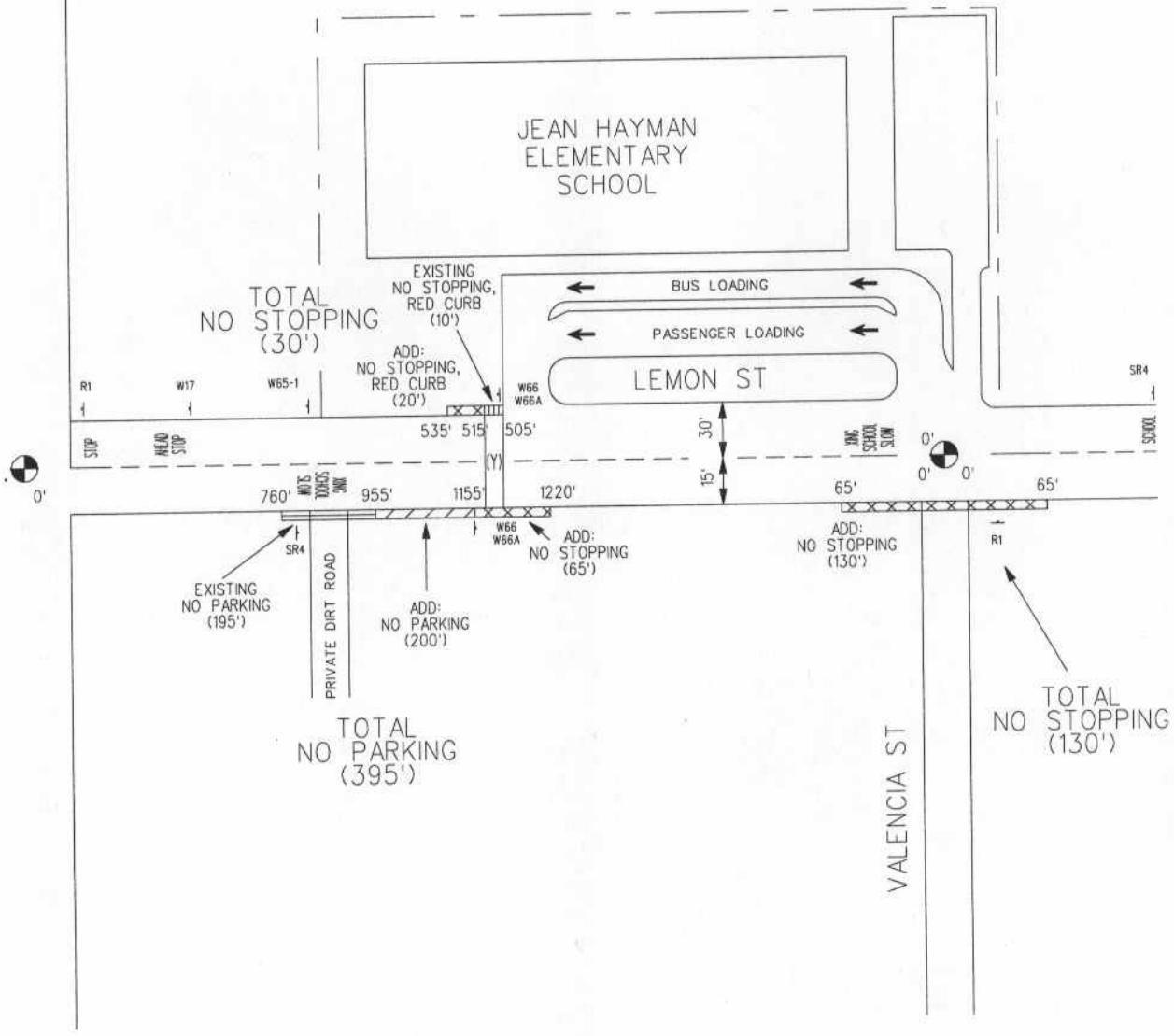






MISSION TRAIL



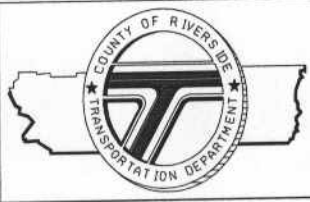
