SUBJECT: Allocation of Third District Developer Agreement Funds to the Winchester Historical Society of Pleasant Valley, Patterson House Museum.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board join with me to:

- 1) Approve the use of \$32,000 of Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund No. 30558-1103500000 to give to the Winchester Historical Society of Pleasant Valley, Patterson House Museum;
- 2) Direct the Executive Office to process payment of \$32,000 from Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund 30558-1103500000 to the Winchester Historical Society of Pleasant Valley, Patterson House Museum.

BACKGROUND: The Patterson House Museum is owned and operated by the Winchester Historical Society of Pleasant Valley. Their purpose is to preserve the history of the Winchester area. The Patterson House was built in 1891 and has three outbuildings and an old school relocatable building purchased from the Hemet Unified School District. Since 1994 they have been slowly restoring the house and in 2004 have moved most of the history displays to the Ed and Mary Kinney Building. There is still much work to be done to the buildings and the grounds. They have currently entered into an agreement with the Winchester Valley Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4379 to locate their building on site and partner with them to provide security for the museum site itself. These funds would provide an appropriate foundation, approved by the County, for the "old school building". It would also cover the painting of the interior of the Patterson House itself. I urge the Board to join with me to support this request.
