SUBJECT: Resolution 413-571 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone on Dillon Road, Desert Hot Springs area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-571 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Dillon Road in the Desert Hot Springs area, as described in attached Resolution 413-571.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department received a request from a resident for a No-Stopping Zone on Dillon Road at the entrance to Dillon Estates due to parked vehicles obstructing sight distance of motorists exiting the Estates onto Dillon Road.

Transportation Department reviewed this location in the field and determined that a No-Stopping Zone on the south side of Dillon Road east and west of the Estates entrance is appropriate to improve sight distance for motorists. The No-Stopping Zone will improve safety and the operation of the entrance on Dillon Road.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of the No-Stopping Zone. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Indio Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

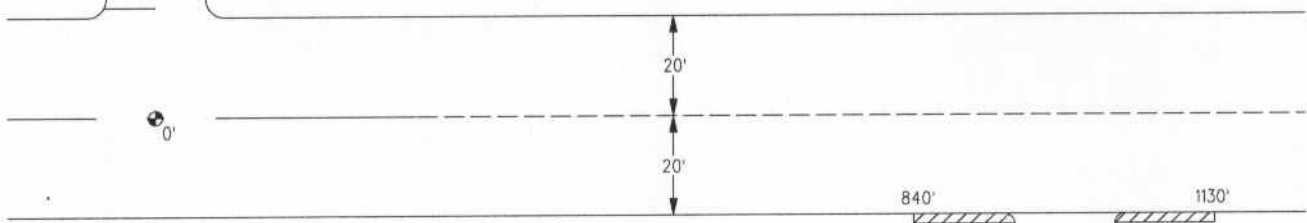
