SUBJECT: I-15/Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road Interchange Enhancement Project, Mira Loma Area – Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Program Grant Application – 2nd District

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Approval of the submission of an application for grant funds from the Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation Program (EEMP – AB471), and the Adoption of Resolution #2004-510 for the I-15/Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road Interchange Enhancement Project.

BACKGROUND: The I-15 Cantu-Galleano Ranch Road Interchange Enhancement Project is a proposal by the County Transportation Department to landscape and enhance the new interchange. It is estimated that the interchange area will have approximately 16 acres available for landscaping. The total cost of landscaping is estimated at \$890,000. The Department will be seeking funds from various sources to cover this expense. Approval of our grant submission allows us to request \$250,000 toward this effort. The EEMP funds, if the grant is successful, will be used primarily for the planting of trees to offset vehicular emissions of carbon dioxide. County Counsel has approved the Resolution as to form.

3 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
4 COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE APPROVING THE APPLICATION
5 FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENT
6 AND MITIGATION PROGRAM UNDER SECTION 164.56
7 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE FOR THE
8 I-15 GALENA STREET INTERCHANGE ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has enacted AB 471
10 (Chapter 106 of the Statutes of 1989), which is intended to provide \$10 million annually
11 for a period of 10 years for grant funds to local, state and federal agencies and nonprofit
12 entities for projects to enhance and mitigate the environmental impacts of modified or
13 new public transportation facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, the Resources Agency has established the procedures and
15 criteria for reviewing grant proposals and is required to submit to the California
16 Transportation Commission a list of recommended projects from which grant recipients
17 will be selected; and

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19 WHEREAS, said procedures and criteria established by the Resources
20 Agency require a resolution certifying the approval of application by the applicant's
21 governing body before submission of said application to the State; and

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24 WHEREAS, the application contains assurances that the applicant must
25 comply with; and

1 WHEREAS, the applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the
2 State of California to carry out the environmental enhancement and mitigation project;

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4 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
5 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
6 _____, 2004, approves the filing of an application for Environmental
7 Enhancement and Mitigation Programs for grant assistance and certifies that said
8 applicant will make adequate provisions for operation and maintenance of the project.
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11 BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board appoints George A.
12 Johnson, Director of Transportation, as agent for the County of Riverside Transportation
13 Department to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but
14 not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on,
15 which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
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
