**SUBJECT:** Allocation of Third District Developer Agreement Regional Park Funds to the Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District for the Children's Play Pool in the Regional Aquatic Facility at the Diamond Valley Lake Community Park.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board join with me to:

- 1) Approve the use of \$66,000 of Third District Regional Park Fund No. 30564-1103500000 to Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District for their Children's Play Pool in the Regional Aquatic Facility at the Diamond Valley Lake Community Park;
- 2) Direct the Executive Office to process payment of \$66,000 from Third District Regional Park Fund 30564-1103500000 to the Valley-Wide Recreation and Park District for their Children's Play Pool.

**BACKGROUND:** The Diamond Valley Community Park and Regional Aquatic Facility will be located at the Diamond Valley Lake. They are currently in the design phase of the park project. The Aquatic facility is 8200 square feet in size and includes six competition lanes; a water slide and a children's play structure in the pool. With a State Park Grant, Metropolitan Water District funds, and community contributions they have \$1,825,000 total funds available for the project. With the increase in material costs, particularly concrete, they are experiencing a shortfall. This is a regional facility and will serve from the French Valley area; Winchester to Menifee, and to Hemet and San Jacinto. I would like to assist with these Regional Park Funds towards the construction of the Children's Play Structure. I urge the Board to join with me to support this request.
