SUBJECT: Resolution 413-576 to Establish No-Stopping Zones on Claystone Avenue, Corona area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board adopt Resolution 413-576 to establish No-Stopping Zones on Claystone Avenue in the Corona area, as described in attached Resolution 413-576.

BACKGROUND: The Transportation Department was contacted by an area resident who expressed concern about parked vehicles creating sight distance restrictions for vehicles entering Claystone Avenue from side streets.


Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and determined that the proposed No-Stopping Zones will improve sight distance for the traffic entering Claystone Avenue from side streets.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of these No-Stopping Zones. The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed zones.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

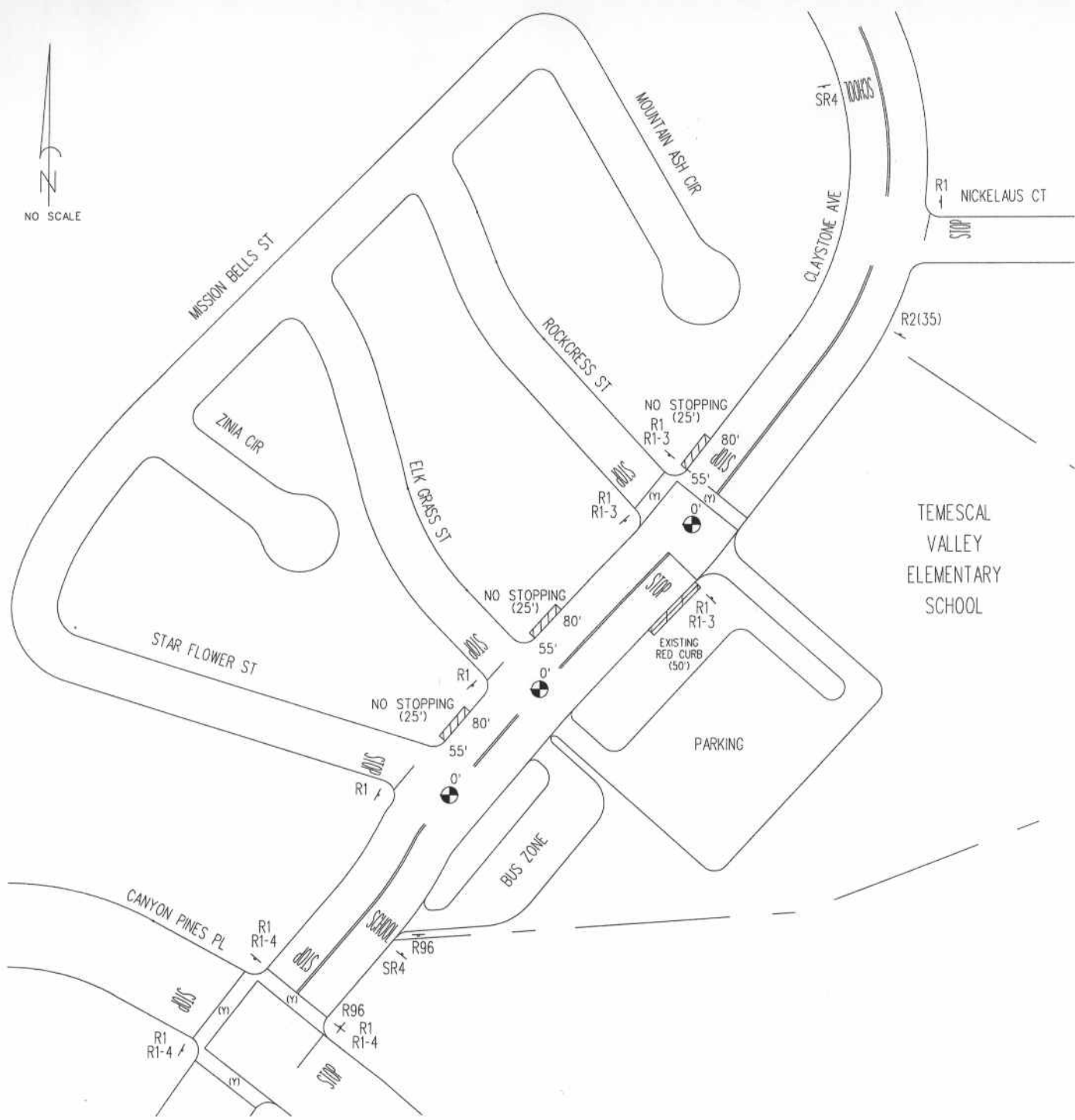

5 BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of
6 Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session on
7 December 21, 2004, that pursuant to Ordinance No. 413, the following No-
8 Stopping Zones are hereby established in the Corona area:

10 On the northwest side of Claystone Avenue starting at a point 55 feet northeast
11 of the centerline of Star Flower Street to a point 80 feet northeast of said
12 centerline, a total distance of approximately 25 feet.

14 On the northwest side of Claystone Avenue starting at a point 55 feet northeast
15 of the centerline of Elk Grass Street to a point 80 feet northeast of said
16 centerline, a total distance of approximately 25 feet.

18 On the northwest side of Claystone Avenue starting at a point 55 feet northeast
19 of the centerline of Rockcross Street to a point 80 feet northeast of said
20 centerline, a total distance of approximately 25 feet.
