On October 21, 2004, the Indian Wells City Council approved and authorized its Mayor to execute a new five-year law enforcement services Agreement with the County Sheriff's Department. In the new Agreement, the City modified the level of service provided by the Sheriff's Department, with the deletion of a Deputy Sheriff position. Staff was apprized of the deletion and budgeted accordingly in FY 2004-05.

On April 20, 2004, the Board of Supervisors directed the Executive Office to review the contract service rates applicable to cities for Sheriff services. With further direction from the Board, a study group has been formed to review the rate structure.

Under the current terms of the Sheriff's law enforcement contracts, any rate changes approved by the Board shall take effect on the same date as County incurs the associated costs. Any contract in effect when changes are approved will have those changes incorporated into the service rate charges.

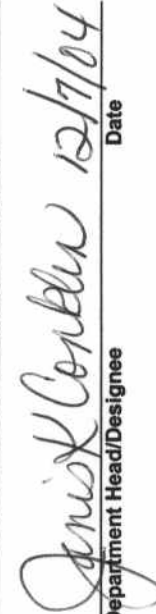
