**SUBJECT:** Board Declaration of a Storm / Flooding Emergency

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

Board declaration of a Storm/Flooding Emergency for the storms of October 20 and 21, 2004, which caused extensive damage to the Limonite Avenue bridge and downstream reaches of Day Creek Channel.

**BACKGROUND:**

Storm runoff from thunderstorm activity on October 20 and 21, 2004 caused severe erosion to the southerly side of the Limonite Avenue bridge structure and to the Day Creek flood control channel. Damage to the bridge structure was extensive, resulting in the closure of Limonite Avenue to all vehicular traffic. Further damage occurred to the bridge abutments at the 64<sup>th</sup> Street and Holmes Avenue bridges as well as to Day Creek Channel itself.
