**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Amendment #2 to the Agreement between Solutions West and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) for C-IV implementation support staff extending the end of the term from October 1, 2004 to April 30, 2005, and increasing the maximum amount of the Agreement by \$134,016 to \$485,748.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Statewide Automated Welfare System (SAWS) Consortium-IV (C-IV) is a consortium of California counties founded as a result of the statewide mandate for an automated welfare system. The C-IV System is a user-friendly, customer-based, on-line and fully integrated information system designed to manage the data for social service programs.

**BACKGROUND (Cont.):**

On May 18, 2004 (Agenda #3.21) and August 10, 2004 (Agenda #3.54), the Board approved the original Agreement and Amendment #1 with Solutions West to provide social service staff who understand and have experience in public assistance programs to assist with a smooth transition to this new system.

Solutions West staff were very helpful during our implementation phase and as a result, we are requesting approval to again retain Solutions West staff to assist with the timely conversion of our cases. Their assistance is needed on an interim basis while we complete the hiring and training of new staff.
