- 1) Approve the attached Agreement #CC0733-00 04/05 to replace Agreement #CC0733-00 approved on June 3, 2004 (Agenda #3.41);
- 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreement #CC0733-00 04/05 between Superior Courts of California, County of Riverside and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to provide child care services for the term July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005, not to exceed \$105,473;
- 3) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign any ministerial Amendments which may include exercising renewal options for years 2, 3, and 4, not to exceed \$126,567 annually; and
- 4) Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) has had a contract with Superior Courts of California, County of Riverside to provide child care services at Riverside Juvenile Court and the Southwest Justice Center for children whose parents have scheduled court appearances at those facilities. These services provide an incentive for Child Protective Services clients to appear on their court dates, thereby reducing the number of out-of-home placements of children as a result of parents' failure to appear in court.

On June 8, 2004 (Agenda #3.41), the Board authorized the Chairman to sign an agreement providing childcare for FY 04/05. Since that time, a third site has been added in Indio. Therefore, the Director of DPSS requests the Board approve and sign this replacement multi-year Agreement #CC0733-00 04/05 for child care services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Adequate funding is available in DPSS' FY 04/05 budget.
