BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC) was established by the Board of Supervisors in the adoption of Ordinance 784, enacted on January 22, 1999. This Commission implements the provisions of Proposition 10, which mandated early childhood programs funded from revenue from tobacco products. A member of the Board of Supervisors is appointed to the Commission.

The re-appointments of the following individuals will ensure the continuity of the activities of the Commission: Public Health Officer (Dr. Gary Feldman), the Director of Mental Health (John Ryan), the Director of the Department of Public Social Services (Susan Loew as Acting Director of DPSS), the Riverside County Superintendent of Schools (Dr. David Long), two (2) members of community based organizations (Connie Beasley of the Children's Center, and Yolanda Carrillo of the Corona-Norco YMCA), one (1) representative of local government with a demonstrated focus on programs for prevention and early intervention for families at risk (Jean Benson of Palm Desert City Council).

The re-appointments will leave one vacancy on the Commission, and a recommendation to fill that appointment will be forthcoming from the Commission. The terms of these members expires on January 22, 2005. Upon re-appointment, the next term will run through January 22, 2008.
