BACKGROUND: (Continued).

The Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved the renewal amendment with Palo Verde Unified School District (PVUSD) on August 10, 2004, Item 3.21 for the performance period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is contracting with PVUSD for the Healthy Children Connection program, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. PVUSD offers social case management services to clients in the Palo Verde Valley area of District 4. This includes assisting with application for medical insurance, and transportation for medical appointments. The Department of Public Health receives funding from the Regional Access Project Foundation and subcontracts with PVUSD for services.

The project in the Palo Verde Valley is in its third year of funding by the Regional Access Project Foundation. Due to a decrease in funding for Fiscal Year 04/05, each partner received an equitable reduction in funds. A discussion was held with the manager for Palo Verde Unified School District to renegotiate the contract. The expected outcomes and levels of service were adjusted to be consistent with the reduced level of funding.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level. Exhibit A and B and Attachment A have been modified for the new performance period, and Exhibit D has been added.

This amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
